TRAIL: Rated 1A, Hard for strollers; unsuitable for wheelchairs; pets must be leashed; restrooms available. The route takes walkers through an attractive, wooded, residential area. Walkers will see a mix of building periods, well-maintained ranches built in the '60's and 4000+ square-foot homes now being built. Also includes popular sections of greenway trail along Crabtree Creek. Some hills may be challenging.

HOW TO GET THERE: REI is located in the North Hills shopping district. From the I-440 Beltline in Raleigh, take the exit for Six Forks Road North, Exit 8-B. Go a short distance to the stoplight at the entrance to the shopping district on the left. Turn left here, and you will see the REI building (a large 3-story building) on the left. There is ample parking. The box is located at the Customer Service counter inside the store.
